MANAGEMENT INTERIM REPORT

For the third quarter of the year 2020 (cumulative period 01.01. – 30.09.2020/unaudited)

Indications of significant events that occurred during the reporting period and the impact of these events on the condensed set of financial statements

In the third quarter of 2020 Varteks Group had revenue of HRK 28.7 million which is 25% less than third quarter of 2019. Varteks d.d. had revenue of HRK 26.9 million which is 22% less than third quarter of 2019.

Decline in revenues of the Group and the Company is a direct consequence of the impact of the crisis due to the coronavirus pandemic in the third quarter of 2020. During August and September, the Company began negotiations with commercial banks and HBOR on a new credit arrangement to finance growing working capital needs due to the decline in revenue which has additionally weakened financial position of Varteks Group. Namely, the purchases of commercial goods for the Autumn/Winter 2020 season and the purchases of raw materials for production needs for the Spring/Summer 2021 season are ongoing.

Control of cash inflows and outflows is a key factor in ensuring business continuity, so control of the justification of costs has been increased in order to reduce cash outflows. Purchase of raw materials has been made dynamic in order to optimize the amount of stock on hand before the start of the new season. The fashion and creative elements of the collection are significantly represented in a new collection. However, in order to preserve short-term liquidity, selected items will be less represented in stores, that is, collection will be supplemented by smaller, more agile and more frequent production, which increases the flexibility of the supply structure. The expected effect is more adequate regulation of the level of stocks of materials and finished products, longer product life cycle and less representation of the new-attractive assortment in outlet stores.

Strengthening the presence in online distribution channels, primarily through own web shop with an emphasis on digital marketing and entering foreign markets where *Varteks* brand is recognizable, remains key strategic determinants of the Management Board in times of crisis.



A plan against which actual performance is compared was made in the second quarter of 2020 and reflects the expectations of the Management Board in the light of the crisis caused by the coronavirus.

In the third quarter, the Company received Government grant in the amount of HRK 1.2 million, which was spent on salaries to employees, while other companies within the Group did not receive Government grant. In the observed period, the Company achieved a negative normalized EBITDA with grants of HRK 5.9 million, which is HRK 1.3 million less than planned out of which HRK 1.2 million refers to lower grants.

In the third quarter, at the Group level, negative normalized EBITDA with grants was realized in the amount of HRK 6.4 million, which is HRK 1.9 million less than planned, while HRK 1.4 million refers to lower grants. Lower grants are partly the result of slower dynamics of exercising the right to grants. A difference between the realized and planned grants in the last quarter is expected to decrease.

Revenues in the most significant Retail and Wholesale segment compared to the same quarter last year were decreased by 29%. Compared to the plan, revenues were decreased by HRK 2.6 million or 16% relatively. In stores, we recorded a smaller number of customer entries as well as a decrease in the number of bills issued, which is in line with expectations. At the same time, web shop sales reached 10% of retail revenue, which is at the level of established global brands. The realized normalized gross margin in the Retail and Wholesale segment in the first 9 months is 29%, primarily due to significant discounts aimed at accelerating stock turnover in order to preserve the Company's liquidity. Compared to the plan for the first 9 months, there was a decrease in gross margin by 1 percentage point.

Revenues in the segment of Contract manufacturing compared to the same quarter last year were decreased by 22%. Compared to the plan, revenues were increased by HRK 2.9 million or 30% relatively. It is important to emphasize that the plan predicts a reduction in orders from foreign customers and the overall decline in revenues in 2020 is still expected compared to 2019 in the amount of HRK 20.8 million or 39% relatively.

Revenues in the segment of Special-purpose clothing compared to the same quarter last year were decreased by 59%. Compared to the plan, revenues were decreased by HRK 2.2 million or 51% relatively. The significant decline in revenues is a result of the delay in signing and implementing contracts in public purchase. Conclusion of the contract with a significant value whose monetization is planned to additionally improve cash inflows is expected at the end of the year.



The impact of the coronavirus pandemic is visible through the normalized EBITDA result of the Group. The drop in gross profit in the first 9 months of 2020 of HRK 19.9 million compared to last year was partly mitigated by good control over operating non-production costs in the amount of HRK 4.6 million. The inclusion of grants in the calculation of EBITDA partially offsets the operational loss caused by the crisis due to the coronavirus pandemic.

With regards to financial activities of the Varteks Group, in the third quarter of 2020 a net expense was HRK 1.6 million which is HRK 0.9 million more than the same period last year. The application of the correct accounting treatment of the club loan resulted in an increase in the accounting cost of interest in the amount of HRK 0.6 million due to the amortization of profit arising from the recognition of more favorable terms of the reprogram. The application of IFRS 16 resulted in an additional interest expense of HRK 0.2 million. Due to the strengthening of the HRK exchange rate against the EUR, there were positive unrealized exchange rate differences in the amount of HRK 0.1 million that arose on long-term bank loans.



The most significant risks and expectations for the future

Illiquidity remains the most significant business risk of the Group in the short term. Given the reduced stock turnover due to declining revenues in the second and third quarters, increased purchases of materials for the new collection, short-term excess production capacity due to reduced orders from key foreign customers and maturing liabilities from previous periods, pressure on the Group's cash position is significant. The impact of the crisis has been partially amortized by Government cash grant, and new measures to reduce working hours will temporarily reduce production capacity and fixed operating costs.

The Company continues to monetize non-operating real estate which is expected to improve the liquidity and capital position of the Company and the Group, and to stabilize operations and reduce debt in the medium and long term.

The following is a chronology of important events caused by a coronavirus pandemic and other important events in the third quarter of 2020:

- July 3rd receipt of down payment according to the preliminary Sale agreement for the sale of
 the property, which marks the start of the monetization of inactive assets. Despite the fact
 that we are in a difficult liquidity situation, it was necessary to forward a significant part of
 this down payment to settle the short-term club loan, which made the financial stabilization
 of the company difficult.
- July 15th a request for Government grants in the form of shortening the working week was submitted
- July 29th a request was submitted for installment payment and partial tax liabilities writeoff. An administrative contract was signed in August, postponing tax liabilities in the amount of HRK 0.9 million for a period of 24 months
- October 1st orders from one of the two significant customers in the segment of Contract manufacturing are secured by the end of September 2021. After that, according to current information, this cooperation will not be continued
- October 9th receipt of the so-called Covid loan in the amount of HRK 12 million financed by the commercial bank and HBOR.

R&D activities

R&D activities mainly relate to the development of new collections.

Information on redemption of own shares

In the reporting period, the parent company did not repurchase its own shares.

Information on existing subsidiaries of the parent company

Varteks Pro d.o.o.

Company Varteks Pro d.o.o. is 100% owned by the Company.

Company Varteks Pro d.o.o. specializes in sewing special purpose clothing for special customers (most notably the police and military).



In the first 9 months of 2020 the Company generated revenue of HRK 15.5 million (the first 9 months of 2019: HRK 24.5 million). The Company generated loss of HRK 0.3 million (the first 9 months of 2019: profit of HRK 1.7 million). The Company's assets as of September 30, 2020 were HRK 7.9 million (December 31st 2019: HRK 7.3 million). Net capital as of September 30, 2020 was HRK 1.9 million (December 31st 2019: HRK 2.1 million). The number of employees was 33 as of September 30, 2020 (December 31st 2019: 32). The director of the company is Ms. Natalija Vnučec.

V-projekt d.o.o.

Company V-projekt d.o.o. is 100% owned by the Company.

Company V-projekt d.o.o. has no operational activities.

In the first 9 months of 2020 the Company generated revenue of HRK 612 thousand (the first 9 months of 2019: HRK 65 thousand). The Company generated net profit of HRK 524 thousand (the first 9 months of 2019: net profit of HRK 47 thousand). The Company's assets as of September 30, 2020 were HRK 5.2 million (December 31st 2019: HRK 4.5 million). Net capital as of September 30, 2020 was HRK 5.1 million (December 31st 2019: HRK 4.5 million). The Company has no employees (2019: 0). The director of the company is Mr. Damir Rizman. Activities have been undertaken in order to merge this company with the Parent Company Varteks d.d..

Description of the financial risk management policies and exposure of the Group and the Company to those risks

The Group's 2019 annual financial statements contain the required disclosures regarding the Group's management and exposure to financial risks. The management of liquidity risk and cash flow risk is described in the consolidated financial statements for 2019 in Note 38 b).
